# JESUS LOVES CAMP

That's right. I said it. And I believe it is true. Now if you argue that the Bible doesn't say this, I would agree that there isn't a specific reference where Jesus utters those words. However I would suggest that what Jesus did, often spoke as loudly as His words.

My favorite Jesus "camping" story is found in three of the gospels. It is a time when He took Peter, James, and John up to a mountain to spend some focused time communicating with the Father. You know this account as the transfiguration story. Jesus and the disciples had been busy teaching and performing miracles and needed to get away. While on the mountaintop, an amazing transformation occurred. The face of Jesus glowed and His clothes became dazzling white. Suddenly Moses and Elijah appeared and talked with Jesus. When Peter awakened, he suggested they build some shelters for the Lord, Elijah, and Moses. (By the way, this must have been primitive camping. They didn't even have tents!) No sooner had Peter spoken, they were overshadowed by a cloud, heard the voice of God from heaven, and then the cloud and witnesses disappeared. All that was left of this amazing experience was Jesus and the disciples.

"...a voice from the cloud said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with Him I am well pleased.

Listen to Him!"

Matthew 17:5b

I relate this story to camp because, like the Lord, we all need a place where we can go and get away from it all to spend some focused time with God. It is easy to get so busy, even when doing good things, that we reach a point where we have nothing left to give. Camp provides a wonderful opportunity to leave the distractions of life behind so that we can more clearly hear the voice of God and be transformed by the encounter with Him.

I, and many others that have experienced a mountaintop transformation can relate to the desire of Peter to stay on the mountaintop. When you catch a glimpse of who Jesus really is and you see life clearly, you don't want to go back to day to day living in the valley. Many of our campers each summer don't want to go home at the end of the week. They want to stay on the mountain, close to Jesus. But as I share with them, life is not lived solely on the mountaintop, we must go back to the valley. However the good news is that the glorious Lord Jesus that we encounter on the mountain is with us in the valley also! Jesus didn't send His disciples down the mountain alone. He accompanied them. And He accompanies us as we go as well.

In just a few weeks, we'll be meeting with the Lord at camp for summer camp. This ground will once again be made holy by the presence of the living Savior. We are excited as we anticipate the many young people and counselors that will have their own mountaintop experience. Will you be one of them? Will the children of your church have this opportunity? Please pray with us that many will be transformed by the Lord to the glory of God!
